

Instructions

1.) Connect your Desire via USB, select 'Disk Mode' when prompted on the device.

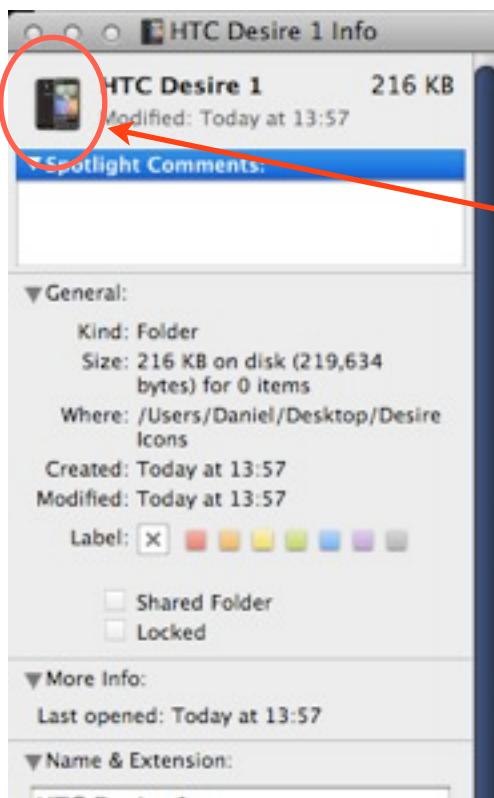
You will see a drive called 'NO NAME' appear on your desktop by default



2.) Open the folder named "Desire Icons"

3.) Select the icon you want to apply, right-click and 'get info'

4.) This window will appear.



Click this icon to select it. You will notice a faint blue outline will appear.

Copy this using the cmd-C shortcut or by going Edit->Copy.

5.) Repeat the above process with the 'NO NAME' disk, except select PASTE (cmd-V or Edit-> Paste) after selecting the Icon.

6.) You can then go ahead and rename the disk and add a coloured label if you like too.



It is also worth noting that this trick of copy>pasting icons works throughout OS X with everything including applications, folders, files and disks.
